

# Half Term Overview

## English

This half term, we will continue to read our class book, 'Stay where you are and then leave.

**Reading:** We will do reading comprehension lessons looking at the VIPERS skills.

Writing: We will be producing some crosscurricular writing about the homemade doorbells we made in design technology last half term, an eye-witness account about the Holmfirth Flood and a Christmas themed text.

#### Maths

This half term we will develop our skills in the following areas:

- Fractions adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. We will also recap converting mixed numbers to improper fractions.
- Measurement in particular, we will look at converting different units.
- We will also revisit the arithmetic learnt to date through quick maths sessions and weekly topical arithmetic practice.

This half term, we will create a Web Page.

## PE

In PE, we will be developing our gymnastics skills in our 'Matching and Mirroring' unit. We will also be extending our knowledge, understanding and skills of Tag Rugby.

### French

#### Science

Our science topic is living things and their habitats. Over the next 7 weeks, the children will:

Describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals. Give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

## RE

This half term we will ask the question: How does growing up bring responsibilities and commitments?

As part of this unit, we will look at practices in Christianity, Judaism and Sikhism.

## Art/DT

This half term, we will be learning about a variety of sketching techniques, such as hatching, which we will apply in work themed around Bilberry Reservoir.

### History/Geography

We will be learning about an aspect of history that is significant in the locality: The Holmfirth Flood.
